HOW TO HAVE PRAYER POWER

James 5:13-18

1. Reach out to God on all occasions. V. 13, 14

- Critical times call for constant prayer.
- Happy times call for songs of praise.
- The sick need special prayer.

2. Pray for others: Have others pray for you. V. 14, 15

- One of the ministries of the elders is to pray for the sick, especially when the sick make a special request for it.
- When you pray with others, you will minister and be ministered to; you will be encouraged and you will see prayers answered.
- If you are sick, you can ask others to pray for you.
- You can call upon the spiritual leaders of the church for prayer.

3. Confess your sins. V. 16

4. Stay pure for real power. V. 16

- Spiritual power is closely related to spiritual purity.
- God will do great things through the prayers of the righteous.

5. Pray fervently. V. 16, 17, 18

6. Pray with faith. V. 15, 17, 18

- Remember, you are praying to Almighty God who is able to answer prayers.
- Elijah was like us in many ways and look at what happened when he prayed. 1 Kings 16:29-17:1; 18:42-45
- If you are living for the Lord and are serious about prayer, you will see the mighty hand of God at work.

3. How can relationships be healed and strengthened through prayer? V. 16

6. What would you like to see change about your prayer life?
7. Who do you need to pray for today? Do you need to ask for prayer?
