HOW TO HAVE PRAYER POWER James 5:13-18

1. Reach out to God on all occasions. V. 13, 14

- Critical times call for constant prayer. •
- Happy times call for songs of praise. •
- The sick need special prayer.

2. Pray for others: Have others pray for you. V. 14, 15

- One of the ministries of the elders is to pray for the sick. especially when the sick make a special request for it.
- When you pray with others, you will minister and be ministered to; you will be encouraged and you will see prayers answered.
- If you are sick, you can ask others to pray for you. •
- You can call upon the spiritual leaders of the church for prayer. ٠

3. Confess your sins. V. 16

4. Stay pure for real power. V. 16

- Spiritual power is closely related to spiritual purity.
- God will do great things through the prayers of the righteous.

5. Pray fervently. V. 16, 17, 18

6. Pray with faith. V. 15, 17, 18

- Remember, you are praying to Almighty God who is able to • answer pravers.
- Elijah was like us in many ways and look at what happened • when he prayed. 1 Kings 16:29-17:1; 18:42-45
- If you are living for the Lord and are serious about praver, you • will see the mighty hand of God at work.
