REASONS TO BE PATIENT

James 5:1-11

1. BE PATIENT BECAUSE GOD WILL DEAL WITH THOSE WHO MISTREAT YOU. v. 1-6

All of us have been cheated and stolen from by the greedy, but we must remember that God has a way of setting things straight. God will deal with those who mistreat you in due time.

2. BE PATIENT BECAUSE CHRIST WILL COME AGAIN. v. 7, 8

Whatever you suffer in this life, it will soon be over.

Soon, Christ will come again. Believers could go to be with Christ at any moment.

3. BE PATIENT WITH OTHERS BELIEVERS BECAUSE CHRIST HAS COMMANDED IT. v. 9 & John 13:34-35; 15:12, 17

4. BE PATIENT BECAUSE THE PROPHETS AND JOB HAVE SET A GOOD EXAMPLE FOR YOU. v. 10,11

The prophets usually did the will of God and still they suffered. Many of them suffered with patience. Follow the example of the prophets. God helped them to patiently endure, and He will help you.
