WAYS TO DEMONSTRATE A LIVING, PRODUCTIVE FAITH

James 2:14-26

1. PROCLAIM GOD'S SALVATION. Ephesians 2:8, 9

Your works will not get you to heaven, but God's grace can.

⁸For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the aift of God: 9Not of works, lest any man should boast.

⁵Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; ⁶Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; ⁷That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life." Titus 3:5-7 See also Romans 4:1-3

2. FOLLOW GOD'S PLAN FOR YOUR LIFE. Ephesians 2:10

Good works do not produce salvation but are a result of salvation. ¹⁰For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

3. SHOW A FAITH THAT IS BENEFICIAL TO OTHERS. James 2:14-17

As a believer demonstrates his faith by works, his life will benefit others.

4. GIVE EVIDENCE OF A GENUINE FAITH. James 2:18-26

Real salvation faith is evidenced by good works.

Some people claim to have faith but do not know Jesus Christ as their Savior but they may have knowledge and belief like the demons do. Real faith in Jesus Christ always brings salvation, but a claim to have faith with no evidence of works is indicative of a person who is not born again.
