## He Suffered for Our Sins. v. 4-6

3. He was hurt for our healing. What is the greatest healing you can experience: Spiritual or physical? Why?
4. He suffered for our straying. How are we like sheep? What did Christ do for the sheep?

3. Why did Christ die according to verse 8? Did Christ die for you?
4. How does verse 9 prophetically describe what happened to Jesus?

## He Died and Arose for Our Good. v. 10-12

1. According to verse 10, what did the death of Christ accomplish?
2. What in verses 10-12 speaks of the resurrection of Christ?
3. How does verse 12 describe the crucifixion and what it accomplished?
