James 1:1-4

EXPECT TRIALS. V. 2

Don't be surprised when you experience trials.

²My brethren, count it all joy *when you fall into various trials*:

“COUNT IT ALL JOY.” V. 2

Make the choice to rejoice.

EMBRACE THE BENEFITS OF TRIALS. V. 3, 4

³Knowing this, that the trying (testing) of your faith works patience.

⁴But let patience have her perfect work, that you may be perfect and entire, lacking nothing.

- Trials put your faith to the test and can make you stronger.
- They can help produce spiritual maturity.
- Enduring trials in a godly way brings rewards. Matthew 5:10-12

ENDURE TRIALS WITH PATIENCE & FAITH. James 5:10-12

Follow the good example of the Prophets and Job.

Study Questions on James 1:1-4

1. What James do you think he is? What does James say about himself? Could you say the same thing about yourself? What does it mean to be a servant? V. 1
2. Why do you think James' audience was Jewish people? What had these Jewish believers been through? Why were they scattered? Why can you be sure that this book is for the benefit of Gentile believers as well? V. 1
3. What are trials? Why should you expect to experience trials in life? What are some trials that God has helped you in or through?
4. What are some examples of believers who joyously dealt with trials? Why should you rejoice while under trials?
5. What are some of the benefits a believer can experience through trials? What are some of the benefits that you have experienced in going through trials? V. 3, 4
6. How are the prophets and Job good examples? 5:10, 11
