A Challenge to the Congregation

KEEP ON TEACHING THE WORD. Acts 14:21

Paul and Barnabas kept on teaching the Word to the churches.

KEEP ON ENCOURAGING. Acts 14:22

- Paul and Barnabas strengthened the churches through encouragement.
- Barnabas had a ministry of encouragement.

KEEP ON PRAYING:

- For church leaders. Acts 14:23
- For each other.
- All the time and in all circumstances. (Daniel's example)

KEEP ON COMMUNICATING WHAT GOD HAS DONE.

- Paul and Barnabas reported about "all that God had done with them." Acts 14:26-28
- Keep on remembering the great things that God has done and keep on telling others.

KEEP ON SERVING THE LORD.

- Paul never stopped serving the Lord no matter what opposition and hardships he faced.
- Whatever God has for you to do, do it and don't let anything stop you.

KEEP ON WORSHIPING THE LORD.

Worship the Lord under all circumstances. (Job's example)

KEEP ON LOVING AND REACHING OUT TO OTHERS.

Paul kept on ministering to believers and unbelievers everywhere he went.
